This year's exhibition theme is "Community." We encourage artists to explore what community means to them, whether that's connection, belonging, diversity, or the ways people come together to create something greater than themselves.

Submission Details:

- Submissions will be accepted from November 17th through December 19th.
- Each artist may submit up to three pieces of original, family-friendly artwork.
- All media are welcome! Including painting, drawing, photography, mixed media, and sculpture.
- Artwork will be displayed in The Arts Hub gallery from January 9th through March 23rd.
- All submissions must be family-friendly, suitable for viewers of all ages.

Eligibility:

- Open to artists living or working in the local area
- All ages encouraged to participate including children, teens, adults, and seniors

How to Submit:

- Submit images and brief information for each piece (title, medium, dimensions, and artist's statement or bio)
- Entry instructions and forms are available on The Arts Hub website and in person at our office.

Entry Instructions for Arts Hub Winter Gallery Exhibition

1. Review Eligibility & Theme
 - Open to artists of all ages living or working in the local area.
 - This year's exhibition theme is "Community."
 - All artwork must be original and family-friendly.
2. Prepare Your Art
 - Each artist may submit up to three pieces.
 - All media are welcome (painting, drawing, photography, mixed media, sculpture, etc.).
 - All art must be suitable for hanging or display.
3. Submission Materials
 - Images of each piece (jpg or png, max 5MB each).
 - Completed entry form (see below).
 - An artist's statement or brief bio (100–200 words).
4. Submit Your Entry
 - Submissions open November 17th and close December 19th.
 - Submit online (via the Arts Hub website) or in person at The Arts Hub office during business hours.
5. Selection & Notification
 - Artists will be notified of selected works by December 30th.
 - Art must be delivered ready to hang/display by January 6th.
 - The exhibition runs from January 9th to March 23rd.
